Vice Chairman Hudgens called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-18-01, a resolution to declare Garland County a Purple Heart County in the state of Arkansas. A motion for a do pass was made by Justice Reagan, seconded by Justice Braziel to approve R-18-01. Vice Chairman Hudgens asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion was approved without opposition.

Vice Chairman Hudgens introduced Ordinance O-18-01, an ordinance to amend the 2017 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-16-95, to transfer funds therefore to various budgets, and for other purposes. A motion for a do pass was made by Justice Young, seconded by Justice Braziel to approve O-18-01. Vice Chairman Hudgens asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion was approved without opposition.

Vice Chairman Hudgens introduced Ordinance O-18-02, an ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55, and to appropriate funds therefore to the Sheriff's budget and the Juvenile Detention budget for insurance and National School Lunch Program reimbursements, and donations. A motion for a do pass was made by Justice Young, seconded by Justice Reagan to approve O-18-02. Vice Chairman Hudgens asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion was approved without opposition.

Vice Chairman Hudgens introduced Ordinance O-18-03, an ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55, and to appropriate funds therefore to the Sheriff's budget for donations to the Boating Safety Fund. A motion for a do pass was made by Justice Braziel, seconded by Justice Young to approve O-18-03. Vice Chairman Hudgens asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion was approved without opposition.

Vice Chairman Hudgens introduced Ordinance O-18-04, an ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55, and to appropriate funds therefore to the County Jail budget for 2018 investment cost. A motion for a do pass was made by Justice Young, seconded by Justice Braziel to approve O-18-04. Vice Chairman Hudgens asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion was approved without opposition.
