Finance Committee Meeting
Minutes
June 4, 2018

Members Present: Chairman McKee, Vice Chairman Horner, Justices Anderson, Mahoney, Griffin, Owen, and Raney

Members Absent: None

Also Present: Citizens, Elected Officials, Staff, and Media

Chairman McKee called the meeting to order and introduced a resolution certifying local government endorsement of Flavor Source Food Blending to participate in a tax back program for consideration. Justice Mahoney made a motion for do-pass, seconded by Justice Anderson. Chairman McKee asked for question or discussion with none; the resolution was approved without opposition.

Chairman McKee introduced an ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, appropriate, and transfer funds in the Prosecuting Attorney's Budgets. Also, to transfer money reimbursed from the State of Arkansas back to the OMH Sale Fund from the Victims of Crime Act Grant Fund. Justice Raney made a motion for do-pass, seconded by Justice Horner. Chairman McKee asked for question or discussion with none; the ordinance was approved without opposition.

Chairman McKee introduced an ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, and appropriate funds in the Sheriff's Budget, Juvenile Detention Budget, and the County Jail Budget. These funds are for insurance reimbursements, three months of National School Lunch reimbursements, donations, restitution, extradition, and refunds received by the Sheriff's office. Justice Anderson made a motion for do-pass, seconded by Justice Mahoney. Chairman McKee asked for question or discussion with none; the ordinance was approved without opposition.

Chairman McKee introduced an ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, and appropriate funds in the Sheriff's Budget to purchase a 2018 Ford Explorer Interceptor Unit for the Lake Hamilton School Resource Officer. The County contracted with Lake Hamilton School District to provide a fully-equipped patrol unit, at a monthly rate of \$573.59. Justice Griffin made a motion for do-pass, seconded by Justice Raney. Chairman McKee asked for question or discussion and Justice Raney asked if this contract covered the entire cost of the vehicle. Comptroller Ashmore stated that it covered the cost of purchasing the vehicle,
