The Victim/Witness Program of the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney assists victims of crime through the criminal court system. The Victim/Witness coordinators provide step-by-step explanations about the criminal court process, what to expect in the months ahead, notifications about case developments, emotional support through the court process, accompaniment to court proceedings, assistance with matters of restitution, referrals to other community services, assistance in the filing of mental and drug/alcohol commitments, assistance in seeking reimbursement through the Arkansas Crime Victims Reparations Board for various expenses, special programs for domestic abuse victims and assistance in registering for victim notification through the V.I.N.E. electronic notification system and/or the Arkansas Department of Correction.
