The term of the contract for pavement marking shall be one year from date of award and subject to extension for four (4) additional one (1) year terms, with any extensions to be mutually agreed upon by Garland County and the contractor.

EQUIPMENT-Hourly rates for the following equipment shall include fuel, repairs, transportation, lubrication, insurance and other expendable items (such as blades, bits, tips, points, etc.) normally included with the operation of said equipment.

- a) Equipment to be billed for actual hours used.
- b) Labor to be billed for one way travel and actual time worked.

MATERIAL-The County may furnish the material (pipe, concrete, gravel, etc.) for the project. The County may, however, want Contractor to furnish the material. In this regard, each bidder is to show the percentage markup on his cost from the supplier to the County. Contractors will be required to provide copies of the invoice for their supplier to them on request.

**SPECIFICATIONS  
FOR ROAD AND DRAINAGE CONSTRUCTION**

**PURPOSE-** Garland County requests bids to provide construction equipment and personnel on an "as needed" basis to do small jobs and to provide assistance during disaster relief. For the purpose of this proposal, a definition of small jobs is limited to jobs with an expected cost of less than \$20,000; however, emergency jobs exceeding this limitation may be accomplished in accordance with procedures for emergency purchases by the authorizing procurement an informing the Quorum Court at the next meeting.

**SCOPE-** At times, the contractor will be required to provide equipment other than what is listed on the bid form, and will be compensated for the equipment, i.e., trench box, street sweeper, boring machines etc. Incidentals such as hand tools, signs, barricades and delivery of equipment should be included in the bid item for the equipment. The County can, at times, assist in making street sweepers available on the job; however, the County may void this contract if a licensed contractor cannot maintain his job in a safe, clean and responsible fashion.

**GENERAL-** The County anticipates that all bids received will be approved. The County will, as the need arises for service, evaluate the bids and determine the bidder that offers the lowest cost for the particular project to be accomplished considering the equipment, labor, etc. needed for that particular project. The only foreseeable time when the County will utilize the second and third bidder is when the task cannot be completed by the low bidder in the amount of time and with the equipment available to the contractor at that particular time. The County is not in the position to negotiate the contract pricing with the second or third bidder pricing, as the contractors state in their bid, the bid price is what the bidder will do the work for and is not negotiable by the County. **CONTRACTORS MUST NOT, EXCEPT IN COUNTY JUDGE DECLARED EMERGENCIES, PERFORM WITHOUT PREVIOUS COUNTY APPROVAL.**

**AVAILABILITY-** The nature of these services normally constitutes an emergency, and the bidder must begin the work within a minimum of seven (7) calendar days after notification. The work must be pursued in a full-time manner.

**LICENSE-** All contractors must, before doing any work for the County, obtain the appropriate license from the Arkansas Contractors Licensing Board; bids may be submitted without the proper license but it will have to be obtained before doing work for the County.

**PLANS, ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION-** The County will provide all plans, specifications and surveying necessary to complete the work. The County will provide construction inspection of the work.

**LABOR-** All days are for eight (8) hours. Authorization to work beyond an eight (8) hour day should be planned in advance. Unless an emergency exists, which should be stated in the requisition, work should be planned on an 8:00 am to 5:00 pm day. Work in an emergency event should be itemized; equipment shall not exceed 1.0 times the rental rate per hour of the eight (8) hour day rate and labor shall not exceed 1.5 times the labor rate. Overtime rates are based on an excess of 40 hours per week.

**EQUIPMENT-** Periodically, the County has a need to rent equipment without an operator. The County shall pick up equipment with fuel and returned full of fuel. Where applicable, freight costs are extra and should be reasonable. Hourly rates for the following equipment shall include repairs, lubrication,

## TERMS AND STANDARD CONDITIONS

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. When submitting an "Invitation to Bid", the bidder warrants that the commodities covered by the bid shall be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service. In addition, bidder must deliver new commodities of the latest design and model, unless otherwise specified in the "Invitation to Bid".
2. Sales or use tax is not to be shown in bid price but is to be added by the vendor to the invoice billing to the County. The County is not exempt from Arkansas Sales and Use Tax. Vendors are to register and pay tax directly to the Arkansas State Revenue Department.
3. Discounts offered will be taken when the County qualifies for such. The beginning date for computing discounts will be the date of the invoice or the date of delivery and acceptance, whichever is later.
4. When bidding other than the brand and/or model specified in the "Invitation to Bid", the brand and/or model must be listed and descriptive literature attached to bid document.
5. Identical Bids: In the event of two or more identical low bids, Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-22-111 shall apply.
6. Specifications furnished with this "Invitation to Bid" are intended to establish a desired quality or performance level, or other minimum dimensions and capacities, which will provide the best product available at the lowest possible price. Other than designated brands and/or models approved as equal to designated products shall receive equal consideration.
7. Samples of items when required must be furnished free and, if not called for within 30 days from the date of the bid opening, will become the property of Garland County.
8. Prices quoted shall be "Free on Board" (F.O.B.) to destination at designated facility within Garland County. Charges may not be added after the bid is opened.
9. In the event a contract is entered into pursuant to the "Invitation to Bid", the bidder shall not discriminate against any qualified employee or applicant for employment because of race, sex, color, creed, national origin or ancestry. The bidder must include in any and all subcontracts, a provision similar to above.
10. The Purchasing Department reserves the right to award items, all or none, or by line item(s).
11. Quality, time and probability of performance may be factors in making an award.
12. Guarantees and warranties should be submitted with the bid, as they may be a consideration in making an award.
13. Any ambiguity in any bid as the result of omission, error, lack of clarity or noncompliance by the bidder with specification, instructions and all conditions of bidding shall be construed in the light most favorable to the County.
14. The bid number must be stated on the face of the sealed envelope. If it is not, the envelope will be opened to be identified and the bid enclosed therein will not be considered or counted in the tabulation.
15. All terms and conditions stated herein shall constitute a complete and integrated document and the covenants contained herein shall not be altered or modified by parol evidence unless such modifying term, conditions or covenants are in writing and are signed by the vendor and the agent of Garland County.
16. **CONSTRUCTION:**
  - A. When noted, the Contractor is to supply Garland County with evidence of having and maintaining proper and complete insurance, specifically Worker's Compensation in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas, public liability and property damage. All premiums and costs shall be paid by the Contractor. In no way will the County be responsible in case of accident.
17. Liquidated damages shall be assessed beginning on the first day following the maximum delivery or completion time entered on the bid form and/or provided for by the plans and specifications.
18. Whenever a bid is sought seeking a source of supply for a specified period of time for materials and/or services, the quantities of usage shown is estimated ONLY. No guarantee or warranty is given or implied by the participants as to the total amount that may or may not be purchased from any resulting contracts. These quantities are for the bidders' information ONLY and will be used for tabulation and presentation of the bid and the participant reserves the right to increase or decrease quantities as required. Bidder agrees to this condition upon the signing of this document.
19. Garland County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to accept in whole or in part, to waive any informalities or technicalities in bids received, to accept bids on materials or equipment with variations from specifications in those cases where efficiency of operation will not be impaired and unless otherwise specified by the bidder, to accept any item in the bid. If unit prices and extensions thereof do not coincide, Garland County may accept the bid for the lesser amount whether reflected by the extension or by the correct multiple of the unit price.
20. As required by Arkansas State Law, an Arkansas State Contractors License is required for any work bid over \$20,000.00.

**DELIVERY:**

Garland County requests work to begin within 5 days after receipt of order. If Contractor fails to meet this delivery date, liquidated damages in the amount of \$1,000.00 per day will be imposed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day and/or Garland County will have the option to go to the next lowest responsive bidder for completion of the project. If this delivery schedule can't be met, bidder must state number of days they require to place commodity in Garland County's designated locations. Failure to state delivery time obligates bidder to complete delivery within Garland County's requested timeframe. Should successful bidder not meet delivery requirements, the County will move to the next lowest contractors responsive bid.

**NON-APPROPRIATION CLAUSE:**

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Agreement to the contrary, if the Garland County Quorum Court fails to appropriate funds for subsequent period within the term of this Agreement, the County shall not be obligated to make payments beyond the then current fiscal appropriations period provided that Company shall have received a written notification of the occurrence of the following events:

- a) Funds are not appropriated for a subsequent period during the Term of this Agreement for the acquisition of services and functions which, in whole or in part, are essentially the same services and functions for the performance of which the services and functions were purchased;
- b) County has exhausted all funds legally available for all payments due under this Agreement; and
- c) Such non-appropriation did not result from any act or failure to act of County.

Then, Company's only remedy shall be to terminate this Agreement at the end of the period which notice is given and take possession of any equipment owned by the Company. Company shall be entitled, however, to any payments and other payments due and owing during any previous period.

**SCOPE:**

The purpose of this Invitation to Bid (ITB) is to establish a contract for application of pavement markings for the Garland County Road and Bridge Department. Bid prices shall include all labor and materials necessary to perform the job in accordance with the standards of performance. **Award of this contract shall be "ALL OR NONE".**

## **STANDARD OF PERFORMANCE:**

The Company shall perform according to the terms and conditions as stated herein, and according to the highest standards and commercial practices. Poor performance will be deemed a breach of the specifications of the Invitation to Bid, and shall be grounds for immediate termination of the contract. Garland County retains the absolute right to assess whether and when performance is subsequently acceptable and not acceptable by the County.

## **INDEMNIFICATION:**

The Company hereby agrees to assume all risks and responsibilities inherent in performing the contracted services and does hereby agree to defend, hold harmless, indemnify, release and forever discharge Garland County Government and any of its officers, agents, employees, volunteers and servants from and against any and all claims, demands, and actions, causes of action, losses liabilities, or expenditures of any kind, including court cost and expenses, accruing or resulting from any suits or damages of any character resulting from injuries, damages, or death sustained by any person or persons, or property, by virtue of the performance of this agreement either directly or indirectly.

## **TERM:**

The term of the contract shall be one year from date of award and subject to extension for four (4) additional one year terms, with any extension to be mutually agreed upon by Garland County and the contractor.

## **BONDS:**

All bids must contain a letter of intent from a bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Arkansas stating its willingness to bond the Contractor pursuant to the terms of any contract resulting from the ITB. The Contractor shall procure and maintain, at the Contractor's expense, a Performance Bond for the period of the contract project, including any warranty period. ***Certificates evidencing the effective dates and amounts of such bond must be provided to the County.*** This information shall be provided to Garland County, not later than fifteen workdays, from the date of award of the term contract.

## **PERFORMANCE (BID) BOND:**

- (a) The penal amount of performance bonds shall be 5% of the original contract price, based upon the projected total of this Invitation to Bid.
- (b) The County may require additional performance bond protection when the contract price is increased. The increase in protection shall generally equal 100 percent of the increase in contract price.
- (c) The County may secure additional protection by directing the Contractor to increase the penal amount of the existing bond or to obtain an additional bond.
- (d) The Contractor shall furnish all executed bonds, including any necessary reinsurance agreements, to the County, within the time period specified in the Bid Guarantee provision of the solicitation.
- (e) The bonds shall be in the form of firm commitment, supported by corporate sureties, individual sureties, or by other acceptable security such as postal money order, or cashier's check.

**WARRANTY:**

Services received under this Invitation to Bid shall be warranted for a period of not less than one year from the date of acceptance. Acceptance shall be in written form, signed and dated by the bidder/contractor and submitted with the bid packet. The warranty letter shall be included with the bid, at the time of the bid opening. Failure to provide the warranty letter along with the sealed bid shall be grounds to dismiss the companies bid and declare that bid unresponsive. The warranty shall include full repair, removal and/or replacement of failed pavement markings and pavement markings that have been deemed not meeting the Arkansas Highway Department "Standard Specifications for Highway Construction" 2014 Edition, Particularly Section 718 and 719, as directed by the Garland County Road and Bridge Department and Garland County Judge Rick Davis. Reflectivity Test and Paint Millage Test will be performed at various times during the pavement marking project to insure all material meets section 718 and 719.

**QUANTITIES:**

Any quantities set forth in the Invitation to Bid are estimates. Contractor must furnish the quantity ordered whether more or less than the estimate. No quantities are listed; Garland County may need 1 mile of pavement markings or 10 miles of pavement markings. Whichever it may be, Contractor is to supply the County within the time period listed

**APPLICABLE SPECIFICATIONS:****GENERAL:**

All pavement markings shall meet the requirements of the applicable sections of 718 and 719 of the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2014 Edition. Passing zones and layout of markings must be established in accordance with the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

**PERFORMANCE:**

All paint and beads shall meet AHTD Specifications and be listed on AHTD QPL List. Material Certifications for highway paint, beads and batch numbers shall be brought with the material to the Garland County Road and Bridge Department prior to any work being started for inspection.
