**“A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT TO REQUEST AN ATTORNEY GENERAL’S OPINION REGARDING THE NAMING OF A PUBLIC FACILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”**

**WHEREAS**, the Garland County Quorum Court approved Resolution R-23-14 on May 8, 2023, which named the county-owned former National Guard Armory building after County Judge Darryl Mahoney; and

**WHEREAS**, Justice Dayton Myers, Dist. 7, has subsequently questioned the legality of the naming, pursuant to the restrictions set forth in Ark. Code Ann 25-5-121; and

**WHEREAS**, it appears there are no reported appellate cases or attorney general’s opinions interpreting that section in general or the exception set forth within it; and

**WHEREAS**, Justice Myers has requested that an attorney general’s opinion be obtained on the subject; and

**WHEREAS**, the Environmental Services/Public Works and Buildings Committee has previously met and approved this request; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE QUORUM COURT OF GARLAND COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

That the Quorum Court of Garland County, Arkansas, hereby expresses its support that an attorney general’s opinion be requested on the subject as set forth herein, and directs the county attorney to take whatever measures are necessary to seek said opinion.
