

Special Meeting
Human Resources Committee
January 9, 2023
Minutes

Members Present: Justice Anderson, Peters, Owen, Dixon, Raney, and Brown

Members Absent: None

Also Present: Citizens, Elected Officials, Staff, and Media

Judge Mahoney called the meeting to order and explained that the District 5 position will be appointed by the Governor but is vacate at this time. He asked for nominations for the 2023 Chairperson. Justice Owen nominated Justice Anderson, seconded by Justice Dixon, and the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Anderson asked for nominations for Vice Chairperson, and Justice Young nominated Justice Brown, seconded by Justice Peters

Chairman Anderson nominated Justice Dixon for Vice Chairperson, and Justice Raney seconded the nomination

A vote was taken, and Justice Brown was voted Vice Chairperson with four out of six.

Chairman Anderson introduced an ordinance amending Ordinance O-22-26, the personnel policy relating to grievance hearing procedures, insurance availability to Justice of the Peace, a wage cap on part-time and temporary employees, and declaring an emergency. Attorney Howard explained the changes and why they were necessary. Justice Raney asked about the wage cap and making notes in the grievance hearing, and Attorney Howard explained why the language was changed. Justice Raney commended Attorney Howard for his work on the policy. Justice Raney made a motion for do pass, seconded by Justice Dixon, and the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Anderson adjourned the meeting.

The meeting was reconvened due to a Justice, not on the committee, making a nomination and voting. Judge Mahoney asked for a new nomination for Vice Chairperson, and Justice Peters nominated Justice Brown, seconded by Justice Owen.

Chairman Anderson nominated Justice Dixon for Vice Chairperson, and Justice Raney seconded the nomination.

A vote was taken, and Justice Brown was voted Vice Chairperson with three out of five.

Chairman Anderson adjourned the meeting
