MINUTES

Members Present: Chairman Thomas Anderson, Vice-Chairman Jeremy Brown, Esther Dixon, Larry Raney, Brian Peters

Chairman Anderson called the meeting to order, and Justice Dixon provided the Invocation.

Chairman Anderson introduced Sheriff McCormick's request for approval of a promotional increase within the 2023 Sheriff's Department Budget from Patrol Deputy (3046.0400.1003) to Patrol Corporal (1000.0400.0523). The current salary is \$42,770.69, and the requested salary is \$50,492.22. A motion was made by Justice Brown, seconded by Justice Peters, to approve the salary increase request. The motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Anderson introduced Sheriff McCormick's request for approval of a promotional increase within the 2023 Adult Detention Facility Budget from Corrections Officer (3400.0418.1034) to Area Supervisor/Corporal (3400.0418.1114). The current salary is \$41,852.36, and the requested salary is \$49,916.05. A motion was made by Justice Dixon, seconded by Justice Brown, to approve the salary increase request. The motion carried without opposition.

Chairman Anderson introduced a request from the Law Library Board to approve an hourly wage increase for the Garland County Law Library Librarian from \$13 to \$15 per hour. County Attorney Howard stated to the Committee that previously, Ordinance O-23-4 amended O-22-26, The Garland County Personnel Policy, and adopted a wage cap for part-time and temporary employees. The amended Ordinance requires the Human Resources Committee to review each request on a case-by-case basis and shall have the authority to authorize a greater rate when circumstances warrant. Law Library Board member Joshua Drake commented briefly on the request. A motion was then made by Justice Brown, seconded by Justice Raney, to approve the hourly increase request. The motion carried without opposition.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned.
