Ordinance Committee Meeting  
Minutes  
March 12, 2018

Members Present: Chairman Owen, Vice Chairman Hudgens, Justices Marion, Braziel, and Reagan

Members Absent: Justice Young

Chairman Owen called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-18-05. A resolution confirming the appointments to the Garland County Waterworks and Sewer Facilities Board. Ashmore indicated the need to make corrections to the dates indicated. A motion for do pass was made with corrections by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen abstained. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-18-06. A resolution confirming a reappointment to the Royal Waterworks and Sewer Facilities Board. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen abstained. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-12. An ordinance authorizing the county to transfer property to Crawford County. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen explained the transfer, then asked for discussion or questions, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-13. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, appropriate, and anticipate revenue to the General Reserve Capital Improvement Fund for appropriations that remained in the 2017 budget for the remainder of the AWIN project. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Marion and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-14. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds in the General Fund for a one-way fire escape gate. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Marion. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-15. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, appropriate, and anticipate funds for an insurance reimbursement in the Solid Waste Fund to repair a damaged truck. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-16. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds to various budgets to get a more accurate 2018 budget for grants and various other funds. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Hudgens and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-17. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds to the Sheriff and Juvenile Detention Budgets for insurance reimbursements, National School Lunch, and refunds. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Marion. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-18. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds to the Sheriff Budgets for Reserve officer's equipment. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Marion and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.



An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds to the Sheriff Budgets for a salary increase to the Senior Bookkeepers position. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Marion and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-20. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and appropriate funds to the Assessor's Budgets for a salary increase to the Chief Deputy's position. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-21. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Budget Ordinance O-17-55, appropriate, and establish the County Attorney Budgets. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Marion and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen explained the need for the appropriation and asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.
