

GARLAND COUNTY I.T. MEETING

THURSDAY, MARCH 12, 2020 a9:00 a.m.

A meeting of the Garland County Department heads and/or members, and I.T. Committee members was held on Thursday, March 12, 2020, at the Garland County Courthouse, Room 200. Chairman of the committee, Justice Larry Raney, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Chairman Larry Raney, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Jeff Winter started the meeting with stating that network switches were placed on the 3rd floor, Sheriff's Office, Detention Center, 911 Center, Assessor's office and Tax Collector's office. He also gave an update on Ritter Communications. The internet connection is not available yet for the City of Hot Springs and Courthouse, but should be here in the next 3 months. Wifi will be available to more areas of the city and county that have been requested that are not currently available.

Winter reported that the Finance Department's, FI, and Garland County Tax Collector's, Tax Pro, are being backed up into the iCloud but the records are not purely iCloud based. The attachments are still being stored with the county storage.

LGS and CGIS Justice Solutions are 2 applications not currently in the cloud. Justice Solutions will probably not be able to be backed up in the cloud because of confidential data.

Winter reported that JAVA now requires a subscription, per user, per year, to use their software. The I.T. department is currently removing JAVA from users that do not need it. The Garland County Sheriff's Department uses JAVA, so they may need to look at other options.

Local Administration rights have been removed.

Winter reported that the email rules have tightened with emailing to other countries. Uses are not allowed to email to other countries.


The entire County will go from 100 megabytes to 1000 megabytes when we are connected with Ritter Communications.

Winter also reported that the Shoretel Phone System has the capability to be forwarded to cell phones and have remote access.

Susan Ashmore, Garland County Comptroller, reported that the finance department is going to start the paperless process for claims and payroll beginning Monday, March 16, 2020.
