March 19, 2018

Members Present: Chairman Mahoney, Vice Chairman Young, Justices Faulkner, Reagan, Braziel, Marion, and Hudgens

Chairman Mahoney called the meeting to order and introduced the first item up for discussion. Consideration of a proposal for Cromwell Architects Engineers to conduct a survey of the existing roof and exterior materials associated with the existing, main courthouse building. This proposal also includes a strategy and associated costs for repairs. A motion for a do pass to the Finance Committee was made by Justice Faulkner, seconded by Justice Hudgens. Judge Davis explained the project, and there was some discussion. Chairman Mahoney asked for further discussion or questions with none, the motion was approved without opposition.

Chairman Mahoney introduced the second item for consideration, the design and renovation of the 4<sup>th</sup> floor. Judge Davis explained the need and there was some discussion on the project. A motion a do pass to the Finance Committee was made by Justice Marion, seconded by Justice Faulkner. Chairman Mahoney stated that the estimate is a not to exceed price and would take around 120 days to complete. Judge Davis offered to take the Committee to the 4<sup>th</sup> floor after the meeting, and they agreed. With no further discussion, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Mahoney introduced the third item for consideration, the repairs to the District and Juvenile Courts building roof. Chairman Mahoney explained the past issues with the leaks to the District Court building. Judge Davis asked for it to be passed to the Finance Committee with \$10,000 made available for repairs and testing. A motion for a do pass to the Finance Committee was made by Justice Reagan, seconded by Justice Braziel. Judge Davis explained the parts the insurance would cover and the parts it would not, due to the project never being completed. Chairman Mahoney asked for further discussion or questions with none, the motion was approved without opposition.
