Ordinance Committee Meeting
Minutes
June 11, 2018

Chairman Owen called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-18-08. A resolution certifying a local endorsement of the business, Flavor Source Food Blending, to participate in the Tax Back Program. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-28. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate/transfer to the Prosecuting Attorney and General Fund Budgets to reimburse the Ouachita Memorial Hospital (OMH) Sale Fund. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-29. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate funds to the Sheriff's, Juvenile Detention and County Jail Budgets for several reimbursements, donations and refunds. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-30. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate funds to the Sheriff's Budget for a 2018 Ford Explorer Interceptor unit for the Lake Hamilton School District Resource Officer. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Hudgens and seconded by Justice Marion. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-31. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate/transfer funds to the 9-1-1 Dispatch Center and the 9-1-1 Budget to pay for a service contract on the 9-1-1 Dispatch Center's analog recorder. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Hudgens. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-18-32. An ordinance to amend the 2018 Garland County Budget Ordinance O-17-55 and to appropriate funds to the Federal Forest Reserve Program Budget. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Young. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none, the motion passed without opposition.
