Ordinance Committee Meeting
Minutes

August 12, 2019

Members Present: Chairman Owen, Justice Dixon, Reagan, Young, Hunter, and Braziel

Members Absent: Vice-chairman McGree

Also Present: Citizens, Elected Officials, Staff, and Media

Chairman Owen called the meeting to order and introduced Resolution R-19-12 a resolution to confirm the appointment of Tom Bryant to the Garland County Equalization Board. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Dixon. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-19-13 a resolution confirming the appointment to the Lake Catherine Waterworks and Sewer Facilities Board. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Hunter. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Resolution R-19-14 a resolution to authorize the County Judge to apply for a matching grant on behalf of the Prosecuting Attorney. Justice Reagan indicated a correction to be made on the resolution, "persecution should be prosecution," and with the change, he made a motion for do pass and it was seconded by Justice Dixon. Chairman Owen asked for further questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-19-32 an ordinance to amend Ordinance O-16-70 adopting a Garland County employee and elected official concealed carry plan. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Young and seconded by Justice Braziel. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-19-33 an ordinance to amend Ordinance O-19-31 to overtime from full-time salaries coded incorrectly. A motion for do pass was made by Justice Reagan and seconded by Justice Young. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.

Chairman Owen introduced Ordinance O-19-34, an ordinance to amend O-18-56, to anticipate revenues, and appropriate expenditures in various budgets.

1. Sheriff's deposits for two months of National School Lunches for the Juvenile Detention, insurance proceeds, and reimbursement from the US Marshal
2. Sheriff deposited \$187,380.29 in the Detention Facility Fund for commissary and telephone commissions.
3. The Sheriff requested to contract with Fountain Lake School District and Cutter Morning Star for a patrol vehicle for each Resource Officer.

A motion for do pass was made by Justice Braziel and seconded by Justice Young. Chairman Owen asked for questions or discussion, with none the motion passed without opposition.
